

Mary Hanley Registration 2024-25



Frequently Asked Questions:

What is the catchment area of Mary Hanley?

We serve the families from the Mill Woods communities of Minchau, Weinlos, Bisset, Wild Rose, Silverberry, and the Meadows.

Who can attend Mary Hanley?

Mary Hanley is a Catholic School, so all resident students in kindergarten to Grade 6 that reside in our catchment area can attend. A resident student is baptised Catholic or has at least one parent who is baptized Catholic. Any student who has been placed in a foster home of a guardian that is Catholic and resides in our catchment area is also eligible to attend Mary Hanley.

Students who do not meet the above conditions are considered non-resident students and may enroll at an Edmonton Catholic School if there is adequate availability or resources as determined by the principal and School Division. These families must agree to commit to Catholic education and religious instruction.

What are the age requirements for Kindergarten and Grade 1 registration?

Kindergarten students must be 5 years of age or older, on or before, December 31 of the current school year. All students who are six years or older on, or before, December 31 of the current school year must register in Grade 1.

What are the school hours at Mary Hanley?

The first bell rings at 8:10 am. Grades 1 – 6 finish the day at 2:40 pm. Early dismissal on Thursday is at 12:04 pm. Kindergarten classes are 8:10 to 11:10 am (morning class)

and 11:40 am to 2:40 pm (afternoon class). There are no Kindergarten classes on Thursdays.

How many students attend Mary Hanley?

Currently the population is 370 students. We have two classes of each grade.

Is bussing available for students at Mary Hanley?

Bussing is available for students in kindergarten to Grade 6 who live within the catchment area of Mary Hanley School. Some students may live too close to receive bussing. If you live outside the catchment area, you will not qualify for bussing. To determine if your child qualifies for bussing, visit the following link

Do you need to fill out a new registration form if you are moving from another Edmonton Catholic School?

If your child is currently registered in another Edmonton Catholic School, you do not need to fill a registration form. You can contact your current school to discuss a transfer to Mary Hanley and complete your Pre-enrollment in PowerSchool, to indicate Mary Hanley before March 15th.

What supports are available to students and families at Mary Hanley?

Recent supports for the 2023-24 school year included:

- Educational Assistants (EA)
- Emotional Behaviour Specialist (EBS)
- Therapeutic Assistant – Speech and Language (TA-SL)
- Therapeutic Assistant – Behaviour Therapy (TA-BT)
- Learning Coach
- English Language Learner Support

****These supports are contingent upon student need and funding from Division/Government.***

What technology is available at Mary Hanley?

We have a computer lab, one Chromebook cart per grade level, Smartboards, and FM systems in each classroom. Our Makerspace contains two 3D printers and a variety of coding tools.

Is French as a Second Language Available?

French as a Second Language (FSL) is currently offered in grades 4 – 6.

Is a music program offered at Mary Hanley?

Students in Grade 1 - 6 receive music instruction from a qualified music teacher two times a week. Kindergarten students receive instruction one time per week. We currently have one musical performance each year (Christmas or Spring).

What extracurricular activities are available at Mary Hanley?

Cross Country running, Running Room Games, Knitting Club, Art club, Reading Club, Library Helpers, AMA Patrollers, Grade 6 Monitors, Volleyball, Basketball, School Spirit Leadership Club, Choir, Lego Club, 3-D Printing Club, Intramurals; are examples of activities that have occurred recently. Clubs are contingent on students and staff interests each year.

How do I register at Mary Hanley?

New registrations to our school require ECSD online registration form to be completed and copies of the following to be submitted to the school:

- ***Birth certificate***
- ***Baptismal certificate if applicable***
- ***Legal Canadian Documents if not Canadian born (Residency/Citizenship)***
- ***Proof of Residency to verify home address (e.g. utility bill)***
- ***Alberta Driver's License Information***
